## JAKAB ANDREA-BRENDA



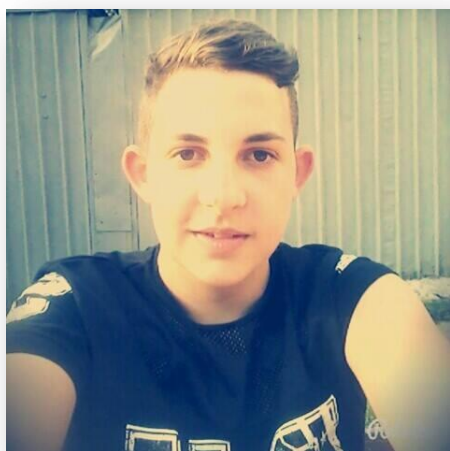
### The family

### **III. SHORT INFORMATION ABOUT VISIT IN OUR COUNTRY**

From 1st to 6th of June 2015 in Technical College "Anghel Saligny" from Cluj-Napoca will be held the 7th project meeting. The city is located in the centre of Transylvania, on the valley of Somesul Mic and has an area of 179.5 km<sup>2</sup>. Population: about 395.000 inhabitants.

Cluj-Napoca is the seat of Cluj County and the spiritual and economic capital of Transylvania as well as an influential academic and medical centre; the heart of multiculturalism and diversity, Cluj is the city where the past, the present and the future forged the identity and local specifics.

Although Cluj citizens spoke different languages, they knew how to live together in harmony, to mutually accept and respect the values of a city which always hosted different ethnics, religions and social classes. For these reasons, the most valuable and sustainable richness of the treasure city is that remarkable art of living together.

The educative activities included in the agenda of the meeting are: workshops, conferences, dance performances and study visits. Study visits will target the cultural sites of the city and region, linked to the project theme: cultural heritage in a pluralistic society.
